



Unwrapping the Possibilities of Jesus In Your Life

Dear Partner,

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. I'd like to talk to you about unwrapping the possibilities of Jesus in Your life. When something is made possible, it is made practical or feasible. Now let's apply this with what Jesus said. Jesus said in Mark 10:27 "....With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible." In other words, with God all things become practical and, or, feasible. The impossible is made practical and, or, feasible with God! This Christmas I want you to set aside any problem or setback that may tempt you to become depressed and realize that with God all things are possible.

I want to begin by saying that Jesus is the greatest gift this world has ever known. However, you must unwrap Him properly. Apostle Thompson, what do you mean? I mean you must come to know who Jesus is and what He can do in your life. There are spiritual possibilities that you can possess in this lifetime. They are: Building in the Spirit, Birthing in the Spirit, which is conceiving things supernaturally, and Blessings in the Spirit. Many Christians are still suffering because they have not seen nor been able to accept the Spiritual side of Christmas properly. They have only unwrapped Jesus in a physical sense.

Let me further elaborate. Luke 2:7 says, "And she brought forth her first born son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn." Now, if you unwrap Jesus from this sense you will only see Him in a limited aspect. In this scripture Jesus is a lad entering this world, in a sense, limited because He was wrapped in swaddling clothes, He only had a manger to sleep in because His parents could not find a place to lodge. THEY WERE LIMITED! And this is the perception many Christians adopt when it comes to Jesus. They carry a barn mentality because the scripture says that "there was no room for Him in the inn." They think that they should be poor because, "after all, look where Jesus laid and look at what He had when he was first born." He laid in a manger where animals were fed. If you only adopt this perception of Jesus, you won't receive the full benefit of what He has to offer.

At large the church is still at the manger. She still has a manger mentality. People admired Jesus in this state. However, Jesus does not want to be admired, especially in this state, but He wants to function in your life.

Now, let's unwrap Jesus from the spiritual aspect. Luke 1:28 says, "And the angel came in unto her and said, Hail, thou that art highly favored, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women." Now, you don't see highly favored when Jesus was laying in the manger, but you see it in Luke 1:28. Suppose you believe verse 28 when it says "the Lord is with thee?" No matter what attack or setback you may have, you are highly favored and the Lord is with you. Tell yourself at least 10 times a daily, "I AM HIGHLY FAVORED BECAUSE THE LORD IS WITH ME!" Luke 1:34 says, "Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be seeing I know not a man?" In this verse, Mary is thinking and speaking from the aspect of her mind. But,

have to go further than your mind and use your spirit in order to comprehend the things of God—His ways, thoughts, and actions. Let's go beyond what happened in the manger, and examine what happened in the Spirit. God is trying to use her in His divine plan for man on this earth. He wants to use Mary to carry out His mandate. Always remember that God uses a man whenever He wants to do something in the Earth realm. All He needs is a willing vessel. In this verse, God is getting ready to set up a new era on the earth. He is getting ready to set up a new Governor to run the Government of Grace. Therefore, Jesus' birth is not just a proclamation but it has a divine purpose with divine possibilities (Read and meditate Mark 10:27, 9:23, and Matthew 17:20).

I want you to know that it is possible today for you to get your breakthrough. EXPECTATION and EXCITEMENT should be a part of your life today. Jesus doesn't only meet needs, He meets desires and dreams. JUST YIELD TO HIM!

I want to give to you what the Holy Ghost gave to me in prayer (and I want you to repeat it as often as you can everyday): I AM ANOINTED WITH POSSIBILITIES FROM GOD!

The possibilities I have from God is that Jesus lives on the inside of me. He is not just a Christmas story. He is not about a Christmas tree, but He is about the Tree that he shed His Blood on, "on a hill not far away!"

Your privilege as a believer is to permit the Holy Spirit to continuously unwrap Jesus in your life. Remember this, as long as you live and throughout eternity, God is going to unwrap Jesus to you. You will never fully know Him because when you find out one aspect, a greater one comes.

Right now it is possible for you to get your breakthrough. Therefore, expect something to happen, expect a miracle, expect your life to change for the better today!

Conceive your breakthrough spiritually! You have the ability to capitalize on the supernatural. You have the ability to trust God to take you further when man says you can't go any further. You have birthing ability! Whereas, you were let down by man God can birth a divine plan in your spirit that will catapult you above the limitations man is trying to place on you!

Finally, I want you to know that there is no name higher than the name of Jesus. Whenever a name is invading your life, such as cancer, diabetes, or lawsuit, the name of Jesus is there to take you above that name. When you begin to feel helpless Jesus' name is your strong tower. IN THE NAME OF JESUS YOU ARE HEALED, BLESSED, AND YOUR PROBLEMS ARE GONE! If you are jobless, IN THE NAME OF JESUS YOU WILL HAVE A JOB NEXT WEEK! Now receive and be blessed!

I speak blessings on you this Christmas season. Isaiah 55:11 says, "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing where to I sent it."
