

God Has Provided For You to Have the Best!

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God Father, and Lord Jesus Christ. I come to you again to bring a word from chapter 16—the final chapter—of my book *Money Cometh to the Body of Christ*. You have to know that **“God Has Provided for You To Have the Best.”** Understanding this statement should cause you to expeditiously thrust towards the prosperity God has provided. I want to build your faith for entering in to the provision God has for you. His provision is where you want to be because there is an abundance of joy, peace and fulfillment of desire. But there are some things you must understand before you enter into this realm of God’s Spirit.

Many people go after material things but don’t realize that material things are merely the fruit, or shall I say the overflow, of the glory that is on the inside of you. **Matthew 6:33** says, **“But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”** In other words, when you receive the revelation of taking care of the things of God first, tangible blessings will come your way.

First you must realize that there must be balance in seeking prosperity. You should not follow some uninspired dream that will leave your faith shipwrecked. An uninspired dream is one that is neither given nor endorsed by God. You can have a dream, desire, or good idea, but if God didn’t give it to you, or cosign on it, you will spin your wheels trying to get a dream to come to pass that was not intended or meant to be. For example, God may desire that you become a minister of the Gospel, but you decide to spend your time and energy developing a good business idea. You don’t take time to study God’s word. You don’t ask God about your first step to become a minister. You just decide to exert your energy towards your good business idea. Don’t misunderstand me, I’m not against business if it is what God wants you to do. However, if the “good idea” brewing in your mind, is not a “God idea” it will not put you in the perfect provision God has for your life. I urge you to take time out with God and let Him speak to you about your assignment. **YOUR PROSPERITY IS CONNECTED TO HIS PLAN.**

Secondly, you must understand that you enter into divine prosperity by degrees. I’m not talking about a piece of paper that you receive from a college or university, but I’m talking about passing God-given tests from one level to the next. You will be tested before you arrive at your prosperity destination. However, You must pass the faith test. You must be willing to step out, without wavering, and do whatever God tells you to do. **Jude 1:20** says, **“But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost.”** Therefore, your foundation of faith must be built properly. If your faith for prosperity is going to be properly built, you must get into an environment where God’s word on prosperity is being taught. On the other hand, if you are in an environment where prosperity is shunned, your faith for prosperity will regress. You must realize that God is going

to test your faith when it comes to sowing. He may tell you to sow an amount of money that you have never sown before, and He may tell you to sow it into a person or organization you don't like. Whether you pass the test or not depends on your faith in God and your willingness to obey Him. **Read and meditate Job 36:11 all month.** I DECLARE THAT YOU WILL SPEND YOUR DAYS IN PROSPERITY AND YOUR YEARS IN PLEASURES!

Thirdly, don't neglect your foundation. Keeping the Lord first is your foundation. God's word will never fail you. Never compare yourself to others. You may be a janitor and think that doctors, lawyers, and movie stars are superior to you. However, In Christ we have an even playing field. God can raise you up, even to the point to where people in high prestigious positions will consult you. He will give you the grace to walk in His prosperity. It won't be an arrogant walk but a gracious walk. Glory to God! Remember this: take care of what God has given to you, develop what God has given to you, and be grateful for what He has given to you, and God will give you more.

Fourthly, remember that the Lord is your shepherd. Psalm 23:2 says, **"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."** Do you know what it means to have the Lord as your shepherd? I'm talking about the greatest being inside and outside of this universe. He is greater than any sickness or disease. He is greater than any problem you may be facing. He is greater than your enemies who are in competition with you and want to see you fail. Verse 3 of Psalm 23 says, **"He restoreth my soul..."** In order to receive God as your shepherd and follow Him properly your soul must be restored. Your mind is one component of your soul and it must be renewed in the process. Your mind must be saturated with God's word so that you can say what He says and do what He does. As a result your faith will be strengthened. When the Lord is your shepherd, your spirit will begin to mature, and once you become prosperous you will be able to handle the responsibility.

Finally, Just know that the Lord will increase you more and more. Psalm 115:14 says, **"The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children."** This is God's desire for you. He is not concerned about you building big houses and riding in fancy cars. Even though they come with the blessing package, however, God is mostly concerned about you working in His vineyard and supporting His Gospel. God wants you and your children to prosper at whatever you put your hands to **(Psalm 1:3).** I SPEAK AN INCREASE ANOINTING ON YOUR HOME NOW!

In concluding, I want you to remember that the best is there for you to have. All you have to do is stay balanced, pass the faith tests, keep God first, let Him guide and increase you. And you should have no problem entering into what God has provided for you. Never give up on God, for he wants to see you succeed. Remember, **2013 IS THE YEAR OF HUNGER THIRST AND BEING FILLED!**
